Scholarship Guidelines

1. The scholarship announcement and applications will be mailed to all Area Directors, members-at-large, local presidents and state presidents prior to March of each year .The announcement and application will also be printed in the ABA News Digest as well as posted on the APW – ABA Web Site.
2. All applications properly submitted will be entered into a drawing for the one thousand dollar (\$1,000) scholarship.
3. All entrants must submit a completed application. Eligibility will be verified by the ABA representative of 100% locals or by the ABA national office.
4. Entrants must be a graduating high school senior who is the son, daughter or legal ward of a member of the Accident Benefit Association.
5. The scholarship drawing will be held at the ABA home office in June of each year.
6. The drawing will be strict luck-of-the-draw, meaning the entrant pulled will be the winner. No preferential treatment will be given to any entrant.
- 7- The scholarship winner will be notified by certified mail. The scholarship will be paid directly to the school that the winner will attend. The winner will be required to submit an acceptance letter and a photograph with a biography. The photo and biography will appear in an issue of the ABA Quarterly News *Digest*.
8. An award certificate will be issued to the winner through the home local or ABA Area Director.
9. The ABA national director or assistant national director will be the coordinators for the scholarship program. They will have the authority to settle any eligibility requirements or any disputes that might arise.
10. The deadline for returning scholarship applications should be no less than three (3) weeks prior to the scholarship drawing.
11. The scholarship award is limited to a one-time amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) limited yearly.
12. Each application will be given a number and entered into the drawing. The winning number will be drawn and the winner notified immediately.
13. Any changes to the Scholarship Program are subject to the approval of the AHA Board of Directors.
